01. Introduction



Introduction

UAE PASS is the first secure national digital identity for citizens, residents and visitors enabling them to access to many online services across various sectors of the UAE and allowing them to digitally sign and authenticate documents and transactions.

It also enables users to request a digital version of official documents issued to them and to use the same to request services.


Follow these guidelines to offer seamless experience with UAE PASS

These guidelines are for use by service providers that integrate with UAE PASS and link directly from their website and mobile application.

To represent UAE PASS correctly on websites and mobile channels these guidelines should be followed wherever UAE PASS buttons or text link to UAE PASS.

Please choose the button style that matches your solution's look and feel and don't create any new style to preserve the identity of UAE PASS and give people a consistent experience. UAE PASS 08

03. Buttons



Button Titles - English

The system provides several options of the buttons. Depending on the platform on which your content runs, choose the variant that fits the terminology of your experience and use it consistently throughout your interfaces.



Enables users to get access to online services.



Enables users to share documents and avail services.



Enables users to register to the service provider channel.



Enables users to sign documents remotely.

Button Radius

Adjust the corner radius to match the appearance of other buttons in your app and web. By default, UAE PASS buttons has rounded corners. you can change the corner radius to produce a button with square corners or a pill-shaped button.



Minimum corner radius



Default corner radius



Maximum corner radius

Button corner radius. You can use a corner radius value that matches the other buttons in your UI.

Button Size and Margin

Maintain the minimum button size and margin around the button in app and web. Be mindful that the button title may vary in length depending on the locale. Use the following values for guidance.



Minimum width	Minimum height	Minimum margin
140pt (140px @1x, 280px @2x)	30pt (30px @1x, 60px @2x)	1/10 of the button's height

You can scale the button as needed for different devices and screen sizes, but you must preserve the aspect ratio so that the UAE PASS logo is not stretched.

Buttons Options

Depending on the platform, the system provides up to three options for the appearance of the UAE PASS buttons: white, white with an outline, and black. Choose the appearance that works best with the background on which the button displays.







White with Outline

Button States and Feedback

Active and Disabled State. The active state is when a button is 'clickable'/'tappable'. While that may sound a bit obvious, the important thing to note here is that a button can be disabled if the user hasn't completed the necessary steps.



Focus and Pressed State. The focus state is when the button has been tabbed to. The pressed state is the state when the user's cursor or finger is 'holding down' on the button.



Logo-Only Buttons

Don't add horizontal padding to a logo-only image. A logo-only UAE PASS button always has a 1:1 aspect ratio, and the artwork already includes the correct padding on all sides.

Use a mask to change the default square shape of the logo-only image. For example, you might want to use a circular or rounded rectangular shape to present all logo-only sign-in buttons. Never crop the UAE PASS provided artwork to decrease its built-in padding or use the logo by itself, and avoid including additional padding.

Button Titles - Arabic

The system provides Arabic button titles. The Arabic buttons are available in the same styles and different states as the English ones.





Button Titles

It should be clear to the user that they are "signing in" to your app, "signing up" for your app with their UAE PASS, not signing up or registering for a UAE PASS account on your app.



Logo-Only Buttons

If your interface requires to use Logo-only buttons, make sure to align logos across multiple sign-in buttons, adjust the button appearance to coordinate with your UI with guidelines consideration.

Always make sure that people can instantly identify your button as a Sign in with UAE PASS button.













Case A. If UAE PASS is the only digital signature option that you provide make sure you use "Sign with UAE PASS" button as shown in the example.



Case B. If you use multiple digital signature options, make sure you state a clear text that says "Sign with UAE PASS". There are two options in this case: Text only selection and text with logo.

Please use what best matches with your platform.





4.3 Continue with UAE PASS

Continue with UAE PASS

it should be clear to user that they are sharing the digital copy of their documents for identity verification purposes and that this step will replace actual verification of physical document.

Continue with UAE PASS capability could follow Sign in or Sign up with UAE PASS but needs to be indicated clearly to the customer that he is about to share his documents using this capability.


Service provider is encouraged to promote the benefits of using UAE PASS to share documents and to provide specific instructions to users to upgrade their account and to add their documents

Case A. A new customer clicks on "Continue with UAE PASS" to share documents in order to onboard on service provider channel.


Case B. An existing or new customer clicks on "Continue with UAE PASS" to share documents in order avail a product or service.




UAE PASS logo in a referential manner on websites and mobile applications to give notice that your product is compatible with the referenced UAE PASS service, provided you meet the following requirements:

Error Messages

In this section, you will be asked to use the following error messages for the scenarios mentioned in below table:

07. Do's & Don'ts



Text Format

Preserve the capitalization style of the title. All variants of the button title capitalize the first word — that is, Sign or Continue; all other letters are lowercase. Don't change this style by, for example, capitalizing every letter in the title.

Keep the title and logo vertically aligned within the button. To do this, vertically align the title to the middle of the button, then add the logo image, making sure its height matches the height of the button.

Text Format

Preserve the capitalization and the space style of "UAE PASS" inside the Button








White Button

The white style is available on all platforms and the web. Use this style on dark or colored backgrounds that provide sufficient contrast.



Outline Button

The white outlined style is available on all platforms and the web. Use this style on white or light-colored backgrounds that don't provide sufficient contrast with the white button fill. Avoid using this style on a dark or saturated background, because the black outline can add visual clutter; instead, use the white style to contrast with a dark background.









Black Button

The black style is available on all platforms and the web. Use this style on white or light-colored backgrounds that provide sufficient contrast; don't use it on black or dark backgrounds.










Logo and Title Colors


Within a button, Title colors must be either black or white; don't use custom colors. For Logo there are two options only (black with green and red) & (white with green and red); don't use custom colors and avoid using full white or black.



Sign in & Sign up

Don't show Sign in & Sign up in same page. Use Sign in within the same page of sign in, for sign up button within the register or create account page.



- Don't make UAE PASS logo
 larger than expected. It may
 hide the content as shown in the
 example.
- Make sure text and button are clear. Use the right size and alignment to provide clearer user experience.




Wrong size and alignment





Text Visibality & Spacing

- Don't use wrong contrast. make sure user details are clear and visible.
- Don't use different alignment.
 Use the right size and alignment to ensure user will take the right action.
- Don't mention multiple actions
 on the same buttons to avoid
 users confusion. Segregate the
 action to make it clear to the
 user as it shown in the example.
